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### Simulation Logistics

- 14 rooms

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### Simulation Orientation

- **Patient Name:** Dianne Jackson
- **Chief complaint:** Fatigue
- **Leamer tasks:**
  - Provide information about the mental health diagnosis and treatment in a way that matches the patient's health literacy and beliefs
  - Provide information about normal aging
  - Normalize mental health concerns to reduce mental health stigma
  - Ask What Matters to the patient to inform treatment decisions and treatment goals




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**Simulation Orientation**

- **Patient Name:** Mary Lee (older adult), Sam Lee (Son / Caregiver)
- **Chief Complaint:** Memory Difficulties
- **Learner tasks:**
  - Assess presenting problem including nature of cognitive symptoms, medication use, and side effects
    - *Cognitive screening and neuropsychological assessment may be recommended for future but not conducted during today's initial session*
  - Engage her son as part of Ms. Lee's care team while protecting patient autonomy
  - Discuss factors potentially influencing cognitive impairment with Mrs. Lee and son
  - Recommend next steps for assessment and follow-up
